EMERGENCY PROCEDURE FOR ALL OWNERS/TENANTS & VISITORS

The procedures for Fire Alarms on your floor are as follows:

- Calmly Proceed to the nearest stairwell, A or B
- Descend to the lobby (Stairway A) or street (Stairway B)
- Stay to the right so others may pass, if needed
- Wait for instructions from Emergency Personnel and Bella Staff

If you need help, cannot leave your unit, and are **NOT** on *The Bella's Assistance List* which is given to emergency personnel, please call 911, or the Front Desk at 609-310-8260. If you can get to the stairwell, wait off to the side for emergency personnel. If not, wait in your unit with the door closed for emergency personnel.

PLEASE DO NOT USE ELEVATORS!

Emergency personnel will be responsible for rescue & providing medical aid.

The Preferred Method Of Alerting The Fire Department Is:

The Fire Control Panel Alerts The Atlantic City Fire Department Directly.

The Alternative Would Be That Bella Staff, A Resident or Tenant Dials 911

The Notification to Residents is as follows:

The Building announcement on public address system.

The Residential Call list of residents and tenants.

The email addresses of the residents and tenants.

The Bella has sirens and strobe lights, and the voice module announces the following:

- **ATTENTION! ATTENTION! AN EMERGENCY HAS BEEN DECLARED**
- **PROCEED TO THE NEAREST STAIRWELL IN A CALM & ORDERLY FASHION.**
- **DO NOT USE THE ELEVATOR!**

Fire Drill will be held annually during yearly fire inspection to test fire systems in the building. Written notice will be posted throughout common areas and on all floors instructing owners, tenants and visitors of procedures during fire alarm. A non-emergency activation the system resulting in evacuation procedures being implemented suffices as a yearly drill.
